On or around August 3, you will receive a link sent to your NEC email account that will ask you to sign up for a 2-hour block of time to move into your specific building for one of the dates above. You will only be permitted to move in during this 2-hour time period. Any student who is on a Wellness hold, Student Financial Services hold, or who has not submitted a negative Covid-19 test will have to be "cleared" when they arrive on campus before they can move in. It is essential that all of these "holds" are lifted or you will not be permitted to move in.

Drop Off Appointments

After August 3, some students who are cleared by SFS and Wellness may be allowed to sign up for a 30-minute drop off appointment. Please note, not all buildings can accommodate this 30-minute drop off appointment. You do not need your Covid test results in order to drop off items, however, you will need to wear a mask at all times when you are on campus. You will have only 30 minutes to drop off items and absolutely no students will be permitted to stay in their room overnight. **This is to drop off your items only. If you are eligible for drop off, more information will be sent to your NEC email.**

Move-In Guidelines

Masks are mandatory for EVERYONE who will be on campus during any move in period. We are requiring students to limit the number of people who come to campus with you for move in to 2 family members/friends. Only students will be able to enter the residence halls on move in day.

Once students arrive on campus, all guidelines in the Pilgrim Promise will be in effect including non-essential travel and staying overnight anywhere without prior permission, wearing a mask at all times other than when you are in your residence hall room or bathroom, and maintaining social distance.
